### Bikes For Kids

Bikes 4 Kids Utah, a non-profit organization, today announced that it will hold its first ever bike ride fundraiser, September 30, 2006, to provide new bicycles for 1,000 pre-qualified, underprivileged children from Boys & Girls Club of Murray, the Guadalupe School and Rose Park Elementary.

Along with the 1,000 bicycles, the children will also receive helmets, t-shirts and locks through the proceeds accrued from sponsorships, a fundraising dinner with silent auction and bicycle rides, including a ride with Salt Lake City native Dave Zabriskie, the third American ever to wear the yellow jersey in the Tour de France.

"I looking forward to sharing something special with these children," Zabriskie said. "Cycling has been my life. It has provided me with a lot of freedom and taught me that exercise, discipline and responsibility can be fun. I can't wait to see the smiles on the faces of these kids when they get their bicycles."

Funds will be raised through a combination of corporate and individual sponsorships, along with a September 29 dinner and silent auction. In addition, on the following day when the children will receive their bikes (9/30/06), Bikes 4 Kids Utah is staging three different rides of varying distances requiring pre-registration and an entrance fee, one of them being a limited participant, 50K ride with Dave Zabriskie requiring a \$1,000 donation per entry.

All excess proceeds for the first year's event will go to the Guadalupe School, Donated Dental and improving the bike lanes in Murray City.
